

How to install SX-Virtual Link as a service to Windows 2003 server

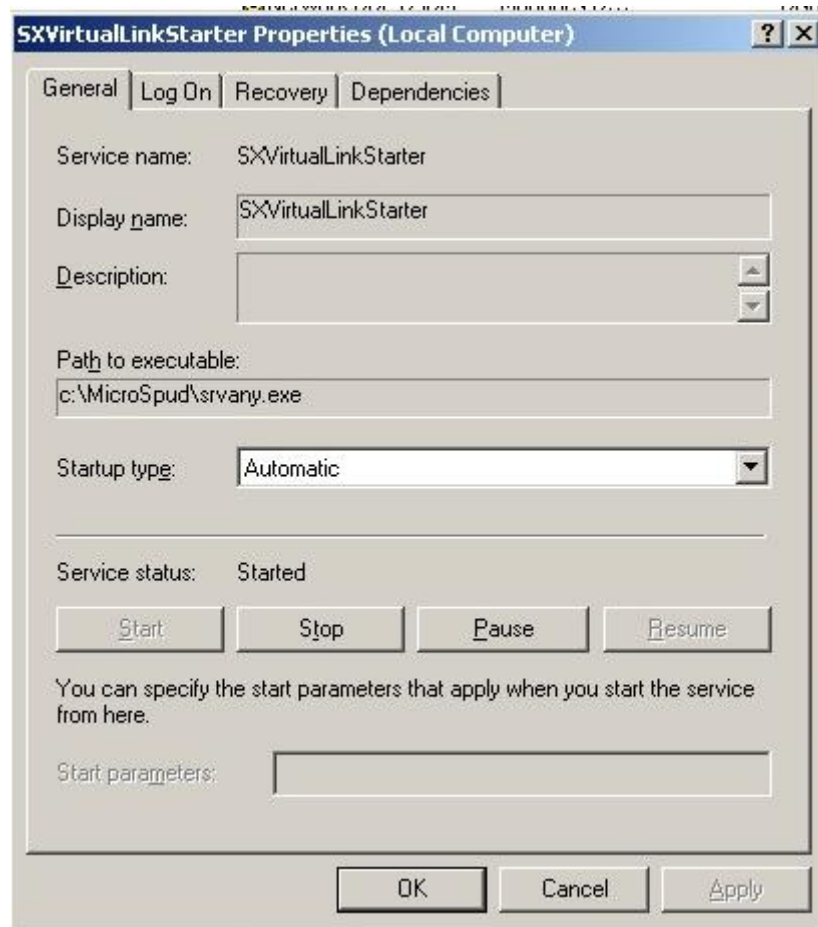
Download

- Please download the Windows 2003 Resource Kit
- <http://www.microsoft.com/downloads/details.aspx?FamilyID=9d467a69-57ff-4ae7-96ee-b18c4790cffd&displaylang=en>
- Just 2 files are important:
- instsrv.exe and srvany.exe
- Put them both to a directory on your hard disk, we saved them to „C:\TMP\


Install SRVANY.EXE as a service using INSTSRV.EXE

- Go to start, run, cmd
- Switch to the folder where instsrv.exe is saved. Type „Instsrv SXVirtualLinkStarter C:\TMP\srvany.exe“ in the new window. The folder maybe needs to be adjusted and the name of the service can be choosen free.
